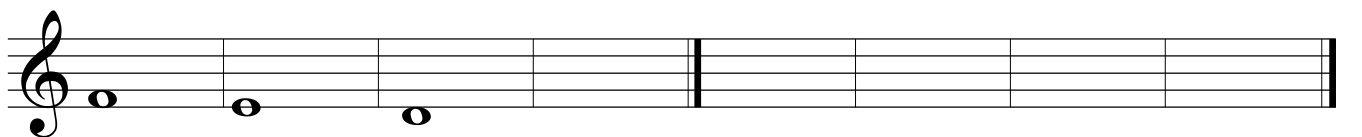
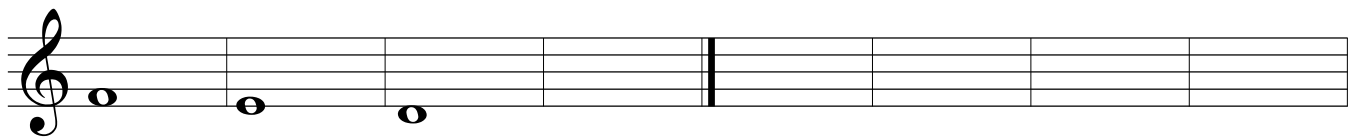
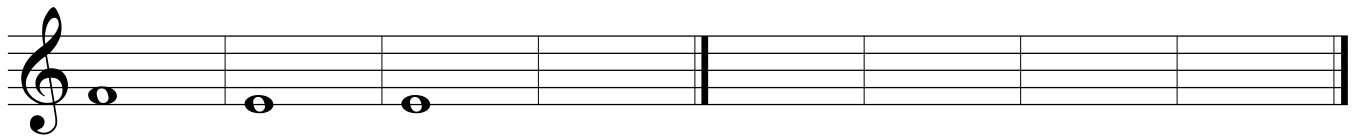
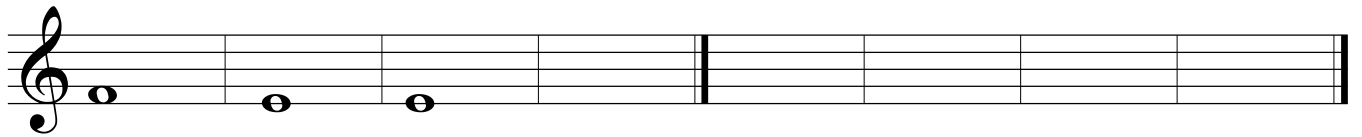
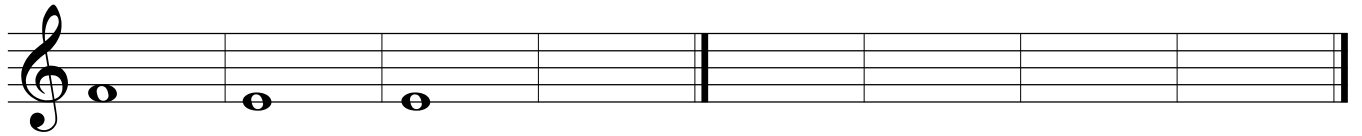
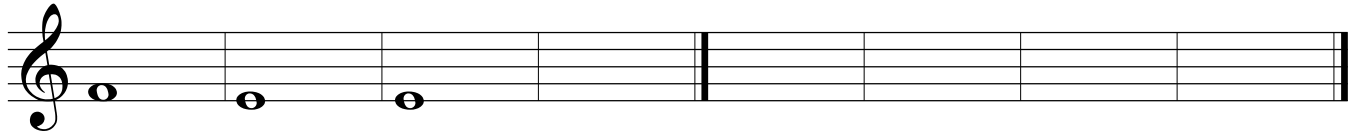
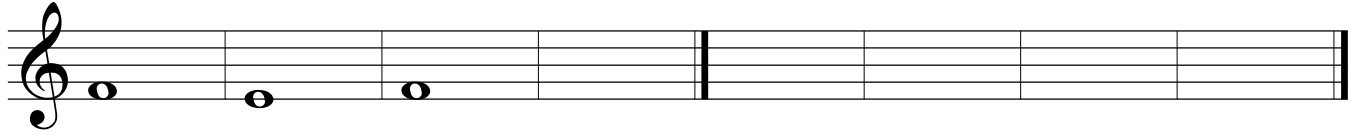
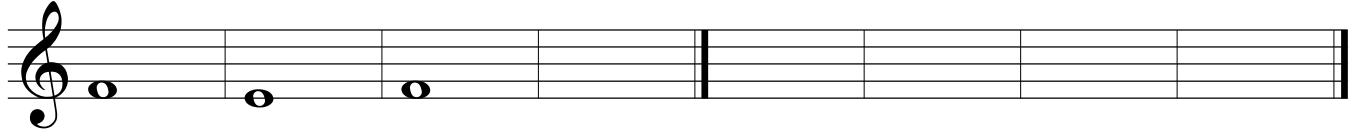
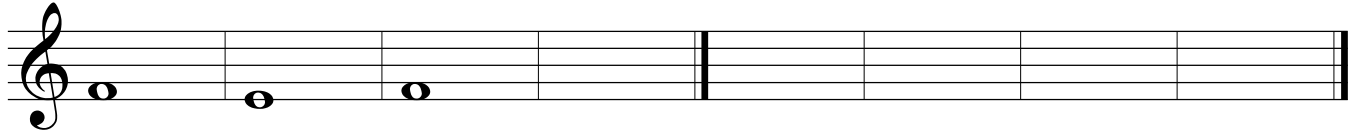


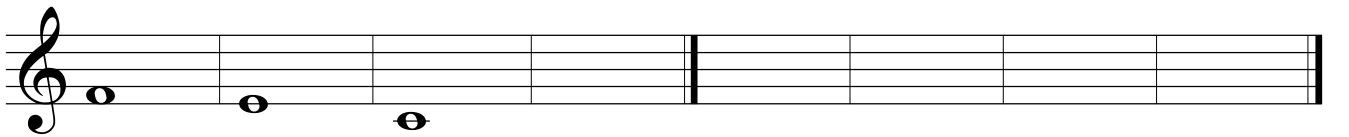
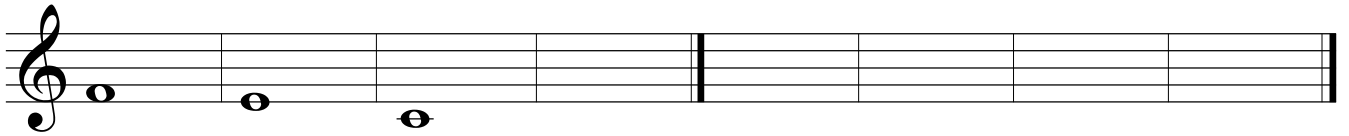
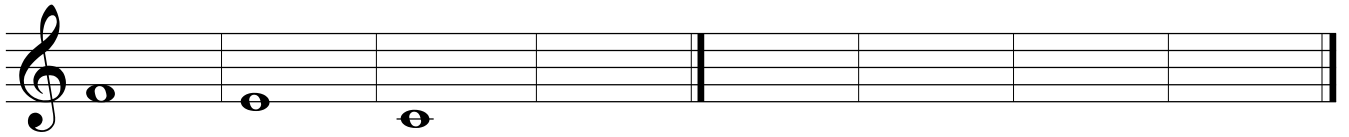
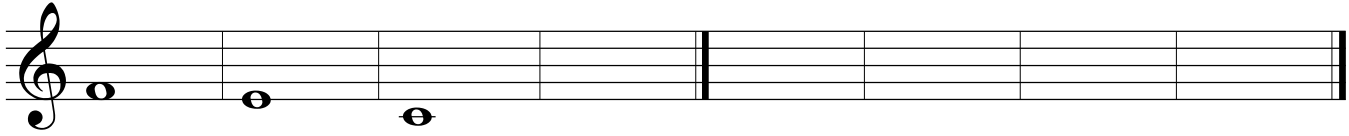
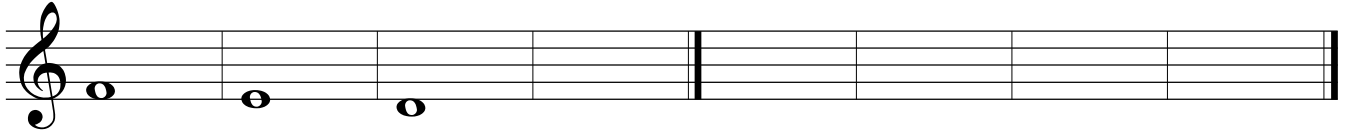
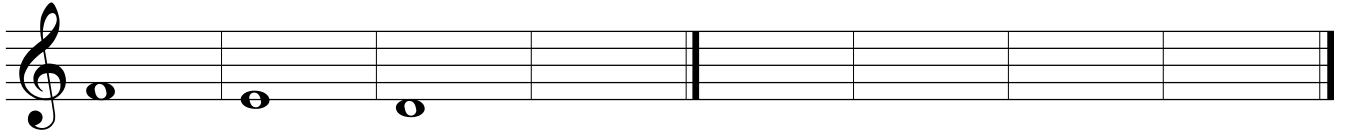
In the next 4 lines, the note in the 3rd measure will remain fixed on 'C', but you add the note in the 4th measure
